

# 2010 In Review

## *A comparison to 2009*

### Collisions

- Number of Property Damage collisions down by 4%
- Number of Personal Injury collisions down by 10%
- Number of Persons injured down by 10%

### Crime

- Domestic violence—a total of 401 domestic violence incidents investigated in 2010 compared to 404 in 2009
- Frauds are down 14% compared to 2009
- Common assaults are up by 17%
- Homicides remained at same level as 2009—one in each year
- Robberies—a total of 7 robberies investigated compared to 6 in 2009
- Weapon charges are up by 20% to a total of 70 in 2010 compared to 58 in 2009
- Break and Enters are down by 20%
- Mischief incidents are down by 31%
- Shoplifting incidents are up by 10%
- Thefts are down by 2%
- Total property crimes are down by 14%

### General

- Vehicle patrols—13,358 hours within the City of Quinte West in 2010
- Marine patrols—73 hours
- Radar patrols—2,749 hours
- Officer Training—4,667 hours
- False Alarms—officers spent over 686 hours investigating false alarms
- ATV patrols—92 hours
- Foot patrols—2,969 hours
- Bicycle patrols—188 hours
- School patrols—930 hours
- Provincial Offences charges are up by 36% for a total of 4,123
- RIDE programs are up by 43% to 309 check stops for the year
- A total of 22,600 vehicles were checked during the year—up by 11%
- Impaired charges were down by 20% to a total of 37
- A total of 797 checks on licensed premises were made by officers during business hours.
